

Young farmers face off for challenge

Young farmers will go head-to-head tomorrow in a new competition to get younger South Australians involved in country shows. The first 'Young Farmer Challenge' will be staged at the Crystal Brook Show in the mid-north.

The Renmark and District Show ended recently after more than 100 years, partly because of a lack of younger volunteers. Amanda Kroehn from the Next Generation Group says the competition will include moving bails of hay and rolling up a swag. "Got quite a few shows lined up across the state to host the competition as well, we are hoping to have a final at the Royal Adelaide Show next year," she said.
