 - Fleeces, which in the opinion of the Judge, are wrongly classified, to be removed to their proper section and judged accordingly.
 - Fleeces may be from flock or stud sheep.
 - A minimum of two exhibits is required before aggregate points can be awarded. Aggregate points will be awarded to 1st & 2nd place getters.

REGULATIONS:

- A total of 10 to 20 sheep will be used.
- Dogs must be kept quiet and away from the area while another dog is competing.
- Next competitor must be available with his/her dog 10 minutes before they are due to compete.
- Dogs biting or pulling wool will be penalised.
- At judges discretion dogs may be disqualified.
- Dogs wearing muzzles will be penalised 4 points.
- The competitor may retire at any time.
- Dogs taking excessive time will be rung off (12mins).
- In the event of a draw, a run off will be conducted for 1st place only, otherwise the fastest time will apply.
- The winning score will be the aggregate of both runs.
- No dog may be substituted for a dog already nominated less than 24 hours before a trial commencing.
- The judges decision will be final.
- Score sheets will be available after the finals.
- Competitors are to leave the gates as found.
- Competitors may assist the dog in keeping the sheep flowing, but assistance may be penalised.
- Bitches on heat are not permitted on the grounds.
- The organising committee reserve the right to change the rules and regulations as required.
- If a competitor's dog bites or injures a member of the public in anyway, it is the owner's responsibility.
- To have your entry accepted you must be a financial member of a Yard Dog Association, unless you are entering your dog for the first time.
- Dogs should be listed in order of preference in case of balloting.

The Mount Gambier A&H Society Spring Show is a qualifier for the VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships.

MEMBERSHIP

All riders, drivers and exhibitors must be members of the Mount Gambier Agricultural and Horticultural Society Inc.

Society Membership fees:

Annual \$30 (includes Member & Car)

Junior \$12 (under 18 at 1.5.11) (Member only)

Competitors One Day Membership \$15 (one single day Member's Ticket - includes car admission). Required day must be stipulated.

Membership to be paid prior to entry of any horses.

CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES

Dressage: 7th October

All other Sections: Post entries **(on the day Between 7am and 9am at the Stewards Room on the edge of the arena)** Pre entry available from 2012

DOGS

No loose dogs allowed on the grounds. Any loose dogs will be impounded with the resultant fees payable to the City of Mount Gambier.

EXERCISING HORSES

Horses are permitted to exercise on the main arena prior to 8am each day. No lunging on main arena unless weather permits.

AGE OF COMPETITORS

The age of all competitors is to be the actual age on the first day of the Show – 20th October 2011. Proof of age (eg birth certificate) must be produced on request.

VEHICLES

Only licensed drivers are to be in charge of all vehicles including motorised scooters and helmets must be worn. All SA road rules apply on the showgrounds.

PORTABLE YARDS

Portable yards are permitted in the secured paddock areas only. As per EA rules, all yards must be of a fixed material and no electric fences are permitted. Yards are not to exceed 5m x 5m.

PROTESTS

All protests must be in writing with a deposit of \$20 in the hands of a Committee Member no later than 30 minutes after the alleged dispute. The deposit will be refunded if the protest is upheld.

JUDGING

The Society reserves the right to substitute a judge when deemed necessary. Persons other than judges and stewards are not permitted in the ring unless permission is granted by the judge. Horses must not enter the ring until called by the steward. Any animal which, in the opinion of the judge or steward, is considered dangerous will be removed from the ring.

CORRECT ATTIRE

Competitors in hack or official jumping classes must wear recognized riding costumes. It is compulsory for anyone riding a horse anywhere on the Showground including practice and schooling areas to wear approved boots and protective headgear approved under the current Australian, European or American Standard – Australian Standard: AS/NZ3838

European Standard: EN1384 American Standard: ASTN F1163

The onus is on the rider to comply with the rules regarding helmets, and their insurance may be rendered void in the event of an accident/injury if they are found to have been using a noncompliant helmet. Riders under 18 years are not permitted to wear high top riding boots, or gaiters, in riding classes.

ENTIRES

An entire Horse, Galloway or Pony will not be permitted to compete in sections other than Dressage, Harness, Jumping, and specified classes in Open Led, Led and Ridden Breeds.

SCHEDULE ALTERATIONS

The Society reserves the right to make alterations to the Schedule without notice.

SWABBING

Swabbing as per FEI and EA Rules and Regulations may take place. The owner or their representative may be present during testing, but shall not interfere in any way with the conduct of a test, and will observe the instructions of the veterinary surgeon on duty.

STANDARD HEIGHTS

Hacks – over 15 hands (1524mm)

Galloways – over 14 hands (1422mm) and not exceeding 15 hands (1524mm)

Ponies – not exceeding 14 hands (1422mm)

MEASURING

Measuring Steward will be available 8.00am – 10.00am Saturday and 8.00am – 9.00am Sunday. Please book a time at the Stewards Room before 8.00am. A Horse, Galloway or Pony will only be measured twice and this measurement will be final. A current height certificate must be produced if requested by the Judge or Steward. Current year certificates from Royal Shows or official EA measuring days accepted.

CAMPING

Fees: \$7.50 per person per day

Camping Requests should be completed and forwarded to the Society with a stamped self addressed envelope at least 3 weeks prior to the Show to allow time for permits to be returned to applicants. Sites will not be allocated.

No powered sites available in Horse area.

Electrical cables – see "Electrical Equipment".

STABLING

Stables/undercover yards available to Members only and on application. Stabling Requests should be forwarded to the Society with a stamped self addressed envelope at least 3 weeks prior to the Show to allow time for permits to be returned to applicants. Applications without full payment will not be processed. For stable/undercover yards, sawdust available. Stables available firstly to competitors living more than 100kms from the Showgrounds. Other applications welcome and allocated on an "availability" basis. If not allocated a stable/undercover yard money will be refunded. A refundable bond of \$20 per stable/undercover yard, and non-refundable booking fee of \$5 to be paid with stabling fees. The stable/undercover yard to be cleaned to the satisfaction of the Committee. Power will not be available in the stable area AT ANY TIME. Please refer to the Stabling/Camping Request for further details.

WASTE DISPOSAL

Stable waste (including manure) must be placed in the skips provided. Day & Overnight Exhibitors please note that all refuse (including manure) must be disposed of responsibly. Please

clean up your area and fill in any holes before leaving the grounds.

FODDER

Exhibitors must arrange their own fodder requirements. A general range of stock feeds will be delivered to the Showgrounds between 5pm & 6pm daily. Orders may be placed by phoning The Produce Store on 08 8725 0377.

TRAFFIC CONTROL & PARKING

For the duration of the Show the speed limit is 5 kph (walking pace). Float & truck parking in designated areas only.

FIREWORKS

There will be a Fireworks Display on the Arena on Saturday 22th at approximately 8.30pm. All livestock remaining on the grounds are to be supervised during the display. Exhibitors leave their horses on site at their own risk.

CRUELTY TO HORSES

Cruelty to horses is forbidden either in the arena, exercise areas or elsewhere. The show is conducted under current EA and FEI rules, where welfare of the horse is paramount.

DISCLAIMER

All competitors, or in the case of competitors under 18 years, the parent or guardian of the competitor, must complete the Disclaimer Form before participating in any equestrian activities at this Show. Dressage entries will not be accepted without the completed Disclaimer.
