ALL DAIRY CATTLE AGES TO BE TAKEN FROM JULY 1ST

All animals must be registered in the numbered & appendix 1 & 2 Section of their relevant Breed Societies.

NOTE: All Dairy Cattle in classes 1 - 85 must be the registered bona fide property of the exhibitor and must be exhibited as registered in the Stud Book or the Appendix Section of the relevant Breed Society.
A DRY COW is one that has been in milk for nine months or more and been milked out immediately before entering the judging ring or a cow not giving any milk, visibly in calf.

ENZOOTIC BOVINE LEUCOSIS (EBL)

Exhibits from herds tested negative status, certified free status or accredited free status or in a recognised eradication programme - no test required.

Exhibits from all other herds - one negative test required within 90 days of the Royal Adelaide Show.

2011 BOVINE JOHNE'S DISEASE

All exhibitors must complete the Herd Health Status Declaration for Show and Sales – Dairy Cattle. Completed form to accompany entries.

The Murray Bridge A & H Society will verify herd disease status with relevant state animal health authorities.

The herd **Johne's Disease** Dairy Score must be 3 or more, and adult dairy cattle that are score 3 must have a negative Elisa blood test within 90 days of opening of the Show. For herds that are Dairy Score 4, 5 or 6, no high risk animals may be presented to the show.

BRUCELLOSIS & TUBERCULOSIS REQUIREMENTS FOR CATTLE

No testing required for Cattle from Monitored Negative (MN), Tested Negative (TN) and Confirmed Free (CF) herds. (The Accreditation Scheme for Brucellosis & Tuberculosis ceased on 31/12/85)

All previous Accredited Free (AF) Herds will assume status of "CF".

Interstate Cattle must meet Form 1 Health Certificate requirements and be only from MN, TN or CF Herds.

BROOMRAPE

Please Note: Any exhibits from properties located within the proclaimed branched broomrape quarantine zone, or from out-of-zone properties infested with this weed, must be accompanied by an appropriate certificate of approval.

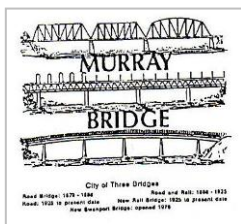

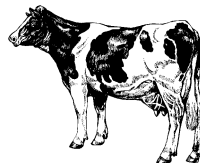
