Must be over 18 years of age

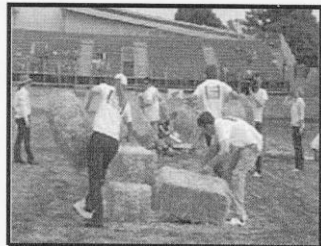
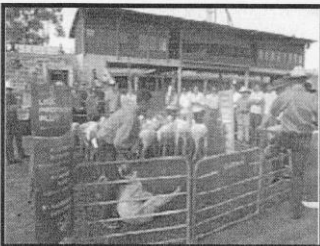
Involves 10 rural based challenges such as:

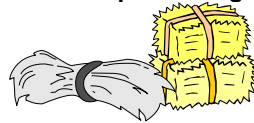

NOTE: Any grain or fodder sources from properties located within the proclaimed branched broomrape quarantine zone, or from out-of-zone properties infested with this weed, must be accompanied by a statutory declaration and appropriate certificate of approval

- 1 Wheat A.S.W. to be correctly named not less than 2 kg.
- 2 Wheat hard variety to be correctly named not less than 2 kg.
- 3 Oats, any variety to be correctly named not less than 2 kg.
- 4 Barley malting two row type, variety to be correctly named not less than 2 kg.
- 5 Barley any other two row, not malting variety, to be correctly named not less than 2 kg.
- 6 Any other variety Grain to be correctly named, not less than 2 kg.

Classes 7 – 11, Samples of hay to be either small square bales or samples from round bales to be shown in clear plastic bags

- 7 Oaten Hay
- 8 Wheaten Hay
- 9 Meadow Hay
- 10 Lucerne Hay
- 11 Any other variety or mixed



- 12 Green Wheat 1 sheaf with roots, 15cm diameter where tied, variety to be correctly named.
- 13 Green Oats, 1 sheaf with roots, 15cm diameter where tied, to be correctly named.
- 14 Green Barley, 1 sheaf with roots, 15cm diameter where tied, variety to be correctly named.
- 15 Any other variety Cereal, 1 sheaf with roots, 15cm diameter where tied, to be correctly named.
- 16 Green Lucerne, 1 bundle, 15cm diameter where tied
- 17 Canola, 1 bundle, 15cm diameter where tied
- 18 Peas, 1 bundle, 15cm diameter where tied
