4. All jams, marmalade, jellies, pickles to be in glass jars 250–500gms.
5. Jellies to be made from fresh fruit and fruit for preserving of current season and preserved in syrup.
6. Please fix exhibitor ticket to jar/bottle with a rubber band – don't stick to lid.

Must be over 18 years of age

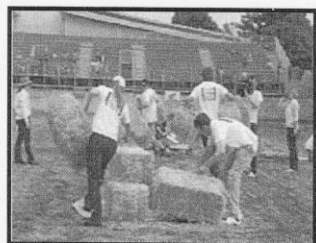
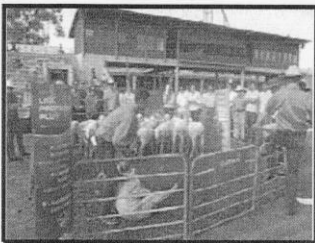
